Thousands of children are living with vision impairment due to the high cost of and limited access to eye care.

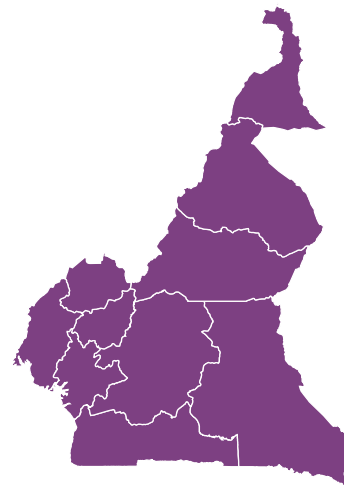


Over 10 million people are at risk of contracting at least 1 neglected tropical disease, which can cause blindness, disability, economic hardship, and social stigma.

Partner with the government and schools to train teachers and nurses to conduct vision screenings and provide no-cost prescription glasses, if needed.



Provide training and resources to community health workers to distribute preventive medication to treat and eliminate neglected tropical diseases.



Ensure families have access to critical vitamins and nutrients needed to ensure good health and combat malnutrition.



Our Impact

- ✓ Screened the vision of more than 42,000 children and provided no-cost eyeglasses to children who needed them.
- ✓ Reached more than 8.1 million people with treatment for onchocerciasis and more than 176,000 people with treatment for trachoma.
- ✓ Provided nearly 5 million children under the age of 5 with twice annual vitamin A, protecting their vision and health.
