2 out of 3 pregnant women don't get enough iodine or zinc, micronutrient deficiencies that make it difficult to keep themselves and their unborn child healthy.

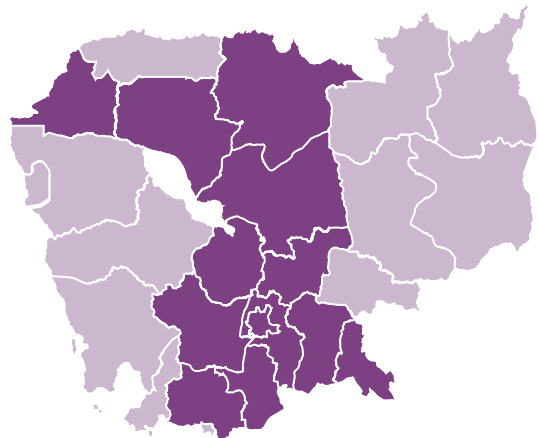


Rising food prices and climate crises make farming more challenging, making it difficult for families to keep nutritious foods on their tables.

- ✓ Supported screening of over 129,400 children under the age of 5 for acute malnutrition and treated 99% of those identified as having moderate or severe malnutrition.
