69% of children under the age of 5 are not getting enough vitamin A, impacting their ability to see clearly, fight off disease, and live a healthy life.

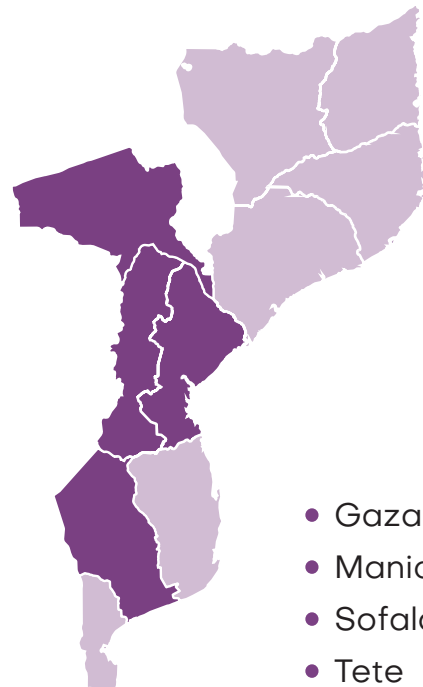


Nearly 38% of children under the age of 5 are stunted due to malnutrition.

Ensure children are screened and treated for malnutrition by providing training and resources to healthcare workers.



Strengthen community resilience by promoting climate- and nutrition-smart farming, village savings and loans groups, and improved nutrition, water, sanitation, hygiene.



Our Impact

- ✓ Provided more than 1.4 million children under the age of 5 with two doses of vitamin A, protecting their vision and health.
- ✓ Screened more than 104,000 children for malnutrition and treated more than 1,100 who were identified as being moderately or severely malnourished.
- ✓ Trained more than 9,430 farmers on nutrition and hygiene in Muanza, Nhamatanda and Marara districts.
